

How to use Eczmol

Eczmol contains an antimicrobial ingredient to kill the bacteria commonly found on the skin, which can make eczema worse, and emollients to keep the skin moisturised. Eczmol can be used directly on the skin as an antimicrobial emollient, or as an antimicrobial soap substitute whilst washing or bathing.

As an antimicrobial emollient:



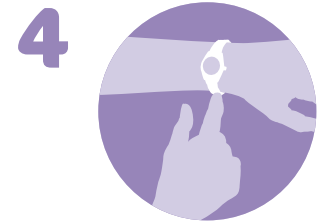
Pour a sufficient quantity of cream into the palm of your hand



Rub your hands together to spread the cream



Apply evenly to the affected area. Stroke the skin gently, avoid rubbing



Allow to dry briefly before applying any other creams or lotions you are using

As an antimicrobial soap substitute:



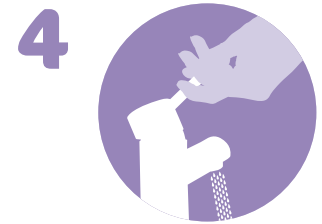
Pour a sufficient quantity of cream into the palm of your hand



Rub your hands together to spread the cream



Apply to the area to be washed and massage onto the skin



Rinse Eczmol off with water before the cream has dried

Eczmol can be used with other treatments for your skin including standard emollients and steroid creams – just add it in as the first step to your routine
